### **Professor Estherann Grace, MD**

Associate Clinical Professor of Paediatrics, Harvard Medical School, Clinical Chief, The Division of Adolescent Medicine Boston Children's Hospital [retired], Senior Associate, The Division of Adolescent Medicine.

Professor Grace is a graduate of the Women's Medical College of Pennsylvania who completed post-doctoral training in Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine. Her academic appointments have been at Emory University Medical School Atlanta GA and then at Harvard Medical School where she became Associate Clinical Professor of Paediatrics. Prof. Grace has worked as a consulting physician at the Clinical Research Center of Massachusetts Institute of Technology and as staff physician at the Department of Paediatrics in Newton-Wellesley Hospital, MA. After working for some years as an Associate in Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital, she was appointed Clinical Chief of the Division of Adolescent Medicine where she remains Emeritus Clinical Chief, now working as a Per Diem Physician in Adolescent Medicine. She is a Fellow of the Society of Adolescent Medicine.

Professor Grace is a former President of the New England Chapter of the Society for Adolescent Medicine and has served on a number of committees in Boston Children's Hospital and in various Professional Societies including the Board of the North American Society of Paediatric and Adolescent Gynaecology and the Board of the Society for Adolescent Medicine.

Professor Grace continues to provide clinical care, precepting and teaching to medical students during inpatient paediatric rotations at the Boston Children's Hospital. She has written four books and has numerous peer-reviewed publications.
